As a youth football club, we are committed to providing high quality standards for all participants in relation to effective management, quality coaching and competition, and safety in sport.

We ask that players arrive promptly and are collected promptly at the end of training sessions and matches. If you are going to be late picking your child up, please contact your team coach and let them know. We welcome parents to the club and would encourage you to attend training or matches where you can meet squad members and other parents. There are many opportunities for volunteering at squad and club level.

The Spartans Community Academy operate a café in the main building, so why not grab a coffee, some snacks and use the free wifi to catch up on work or social media? All profits from the café are reinvested in the social enterprise.

Players should always wear shin pads and suitable football boots to training sessions and matches. The Youth Section provides match kit every two years once the squad starts playing 7aside football.
